At Longfield Academy we have a well stocked LRC. Our resources include, fiction, non-fiction, Careers Information, First News (KS3 Newspaper) and How It Works (a Science and Technology Magazine). The LRC is managed by Mrs Desforges.

All students and staff can borrow resources from the LRC.

The LRC is open daily from 8:15am until 4:15pm. All Year 7 and 8 students have a lesson in the LRC as part of their English timetable. This lesson is centred around reading.

It is the student's responsibility to renew and exchange books during their break-times or before/after school.

Students in years 7 & 8 follow the Accelerated Reader programme - books that are part of this programme are on the shelves in their book level order to make it easy for students to identify the correct books for them.

All books borrowed from the LRC are the responsibility of the borrower, if books are lost or damaged, they need to be replaced or a payment of £5 is required towards the replacement of the book.

The LRC is available as a quiet study area at breaktimes and lunchtimes in order for students to read and do homework or escape the hustle and bustle around the academy for a bit of quiet time. During the day the LRC is also used as a classroom.

During the Academic Year, there are various activities or reading challenges set to encourage reading and visitors to the LRC, from World Book Day to Quizzes or Reading Challenges with a particular theme or Author.

Students may also play quietly Top Trumps, Chess and various board games during lunchtime.
