Dear Parent/Carer

As part of the Transition Programme for your son/daughter to Longfield Academy, I have pleasure in enclosing our Transition Booklet that I hope will be of use to you and your child. I appreciate that you might be feeling overwhelmed by the amount of information that is being given to you, but we aim to make this process as swift, effortless and supportive as possible for you.

Included is an outline of the programme of events and procedures that will take place to ensure that your child's transition to Longfield Academy is a positive and successful experience. Please keep it in a safe place for your future reference and add the important dates on your calendar! Visits to primary schools by Longfield Academy staff will begin week commencing 22nd May 2017, to enable us to meet with our new students.

The enclosed Transition Booklet includes information on the following:

New Intake Evening

This will take place on Wednesday 14th June 2017 at 6pm - 7.30pm for all New Year 7 students and their parents/carers. Seating in the Theatre is restricted and we would be grateful if you could limit your attendance to new student plus two.

Mobile Device Scheme

Information regarding this scheme will be provided at the New Intake Evening as above with a separate communication via letter.

“Moving On, Growing Up”

This meeting will take place on Tuesday 27th June 2017 for parents only. Please attend if this is your first child to make the transition to Longfield Academy. Parents with older siblings at the Academy may wish to join the event also. Please complete the reply slip, attached to the enclosed letter, indicating your intention to attend.

Taster Day

This will take place on Thursday 6th July 2017. All new students will follow a typical day of lessons, meet their Tutor and have the opportunity to meet their “Buddies”. Please refer to the letter in the booklet.

School Clothing and PE Kit

A comprehensive list of all the school clothing that your child will be required to wear whilst at Longfield Academy is included in the booklet. All of our uniform and PE kit is available, via online company, Brigade Clothing Ltd. There will be representatives from Brigade at Longfield Academy on New Intake Evening, where you can try on samples for sizing etc.

Free School Meals

The term “Free School Meals” refers to a meal that is provided to a child or young person during a school break that is paid for out of Government funding. For a child to qualify for a free school meal, their parent or carer must be receiving particular eligible benefits as stated by the Government. If you feel you are eligible to apply for Free School Meals for your child, please complete the application form online at www.kent.gov.uk/education-and-children/schools/free-school-meals or download and return it to Kent County Council at the address stated at the bottom of the form and NOT to Longfield Academy.

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Transition to Longfield Academy 2017

Home to School Transport - current bus timetable included in the booklet

Students travel to the Academy using a range of methods including:

- *Walking* - please enter the site using the pedestrian gate by Reception.
- *Transport* - Bus timetable attached in booklet and details below.
- *Taxi* - disabled drop-off points marked in car park.
- *Cycle* - please inform Reception if you use the bicycle shelter provided at the front of the Academy

The current bus timetable details the number/name of the service and the provider of the service, it also details the pick-up point and time. Passengers wishing to use these services can do so by purchasing a Young Persons Travel Pass from Kent County Council. Applications are accepted for children starting secondary school in September 2017 from June 2017. Parents will be able to apply online at www.kent.gov.uk/roads-and-travel/school-transport/young-persons-travel-pass from June 2017 or they can download a form from the website, also from June 2017. As noted at the bottom of the timetable, any student travelling from Bean needs to apply for Home to School Transport by completing FORMT1A which is available from Longfield Academy or online at www.kent.gov.uk. We advise parents/carers to apply for their Young Persons Travel Pass as soon as possible, to avoid disappointment in September.

Please note that Longfield Academy does not control or lead the transport, if you have any enquiries or concerns please contact Kent at the above contact details.

Biometrics / ParentPay

Longfield Academy uses a biometric image access system to register students, as well as a cashless system for our in-school catering service. Please see enclosed letters for further information.

Admission Form - enclosed

All schools are required by law to keep on record details of children admitted; we would therefore be grateful if you would complete this form and return it to the Reception at the above address as soon as possible. A copy of your child's birth certificate should be presented at the same time.

Newsletter

The Academy's newsletter is available to all parents/carers at the end of each term (six per annum) on the Academy website. It is packed full of interesting things that have taken place in the Academy including trips, awards and exciting events that make up life at Longfield Academy for students.
